The City of Apalachicola will receive sealed bids from any qualified person, company or corporation interested in constructing:

USDA Water Street Sidewalk and Parking

This project includes construction of approximately 420 SY of concrete sidewalk and approximately 1,400 SF of pervious brick parking and other safety improvements to Water Street and Avenue G in Apalachicola, FL.

The bid must conform to Section 287.133(3) Florida Statutes, on public entity crimes. Cost for Plans and Specifications will be \$25.00 per set and is non-refundable. Checks should be made payable to DEWBERRY ENGINEERS INC.

Completion date for this project will be **150** days from the date of the Notice to Proceed presented to the successful bidder. Liquidated damages for failure to complete the project on the specified date will be set at \$500.00 per day.

Bids will be received until **4:00 p.m. Eastern Time** on **Thursday, November 18, 2021** at City Hall, 192 Coach Wagoner Blvd, Apalachicola, Florida 32320 and will be opened and read aloud at that time.

All bids shall remain firm for a period of sixty days after the opening. All bidders shall comply with all applicable State and local laws concerning licensing registration and regulation of contractors doing business to the State of Florida.

The Board of City Commissioners reserves the right to waive informalities in any bid, to accept and/or reject any or all bids, and to accept the bid that in their judgment will be in the best interest of the City.

Small business and minority businesses, women's business enterprises, and labor surplus area firms are encouraged to submit proposals and firms using such subcontractors are strongly encouraged to solicit such firms in the subcontracting process. Any Contracts/subcontracts issued under this procurement must comply with the necessary affirmative steps to assure that minority businesses, women's business enterprises and labor surplus area firms are used when possible, in accordance with 2 CFR § 200.321.
