Section 7. The estimate upon which said budget for the 2018-2019 Fiscal Year is based is on file for inspection by the public at the office of the City Clerk. The millage rate being set at 9.6043 mills which is a .19% increase of the rolled back rate of 9.5862.

Section 8. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its becoming Ordinance as provided by the City Charter of the City of Apalachicola, Florida.
