CITY OF APALACHICOLA ORDINANCE 2017-06

AN ORDINANCE BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF APALACHICOLA PROVIDING FOR A STORMWATER MANAGEMENT UTILITY SYSTEM, SPECIFYING TERMS AND PROCEDURES FOR SAID SYSTEM; PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article VIII, Section 1, Florida Constitution (1968), and Chapter 125, Florida Statute, as amended, the City of Apalachicola has all powers of local self-government to perform City functions and to render City services in a manner not inconsistent with general or special law, and such power may be exercised by the enactment of City ordinances; and

WHEREAS, the Federal Clean Water Act, 33 U.S.C. 1251 et seq., requires certain political entities to implement stormwater management programs within prescribed timeframes; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Federal Clean Water Act, 33 U.S.C. 1251 et seq., the United States Environmental Protection Agency has published proposed rules for stormwater outfall permits; and

WHEREAS, the City of Apalachicola is responsible for the ownership, maintenance and expansion of the existing stormwater system which has been developed over a number of years for the purpose of collecting and disposing of stormwater; and

WHEREAS, the City of Apalachicola has developed a Stormwater Management Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Plan indicates that the present drainage system is inadequate to control and manage stormwater runoff within the City of Apalachicola; and

WHEREAS, the Plan has additionally concluded that it will be necessary and essential to construct improvements and extensions to its infrastructure requirements.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF APALACHICOLA, FLORIDA THAT THE FOLLOWING ORDINANCE PROVISIONS REGARDING A STORMWATER MANAGEMENT UTILITY SYTEM ARE HEREBY ADOPTED:

Section 1 - Authority

The City of Apalachicola is authorized by the Florida Constitution and the provisions of Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, Section 403.0893, Florida Statutes, and Section 197.3632, Florida Statutes to construct, reconstruction, improve, and extend stormwater utility systems (the Stormwater Management System) and to issue revenue bonds and other debts if needed to finance in whole or part the cost of the Stormwater Management System

and to establish just and equitable rates, fees, and charges for the services and facilities provided by the Stormwater Management System.

Section 2 - Findings and Determinations

It is hereby found, determined, and declared as follows:

- A. Those elements of the Stormwater Management System which provide for the collection of and disposal of stormwater and regulation of groundwater are of benefit and provide services to all real property within the incorporated areas of Apalachicola (the "Service Area"), including property not presently served by certain other elements of the Stormwater Management System.
- B. The costs of operating and maintaining the Stormwater Management System and financing necessary repairs, replacement, improvements, and extension thereof should, to the extend practicable, be allocated <u>as a user fee</u> in relationship to the benefits enjoyed and services received therefrom.

Section 3 - Definitions

For the purpose of this article, the following definitions shall apply. The word "shall" is mandatory and not discretionary. The word "may" is permissive. Words not defined herein shall be construed to have the meaning given by common and ordinary use as defined in the latest edition of Webster's Dictionary.

Section 4 - Findings, Determinations, and Powers

- A. It is hereby found, determined, and declared that those elements of the system that provide for the collection, treatment, and disposal of stormwater and the regulation of groundwater are of benefit and provide services to all property within the incorporated City limits, including property not currently served by the storm elements of the system. The beneficiaries of the system include all real properties within the City that benefit by the provision, operation, and improvement of the system. Such benefits may include, but are not limited to, the provision of adequate systems of collection, conveyance, detention, treatment, and release of stormwater; the reduction of hazard to property and life resulting from stormwater runoff; improvement in general health and welfare through reduction of undesirable stormwater conditions; and improvement to the water quality in the stormwater and surface water system and its receiving waters.
- B. The City, under the direction of the director of utilities or other authorized City personnel, shall have the power to:
- (1) Prepare regulations as needed to implement this article, and forward the regulations to the City Commission for consideration and adoption, and adopt such procedures as are required to implement such regulations or carry out other

responsibilities of the system

(2) Administer the acquisition, design, construction, maintenance and operation of the system, including capital improvements designated in the comprehensive drainage plan

Section 5 - Creation of Stormwater User Fees

Pursuant to Article VIII, Section 1 of the Florida Constitution, F.S. Ch. 166, and the powers granted in the Charter of the City, there are hereby established stormwater user fees and accompanying regulations, whereby the City will be responsible for the operation, construction, maintenance and repair of stormwater facilities; for stormwater system planning; to abate flooding, and for water quality management.

Section 6 - Operating Budget

The City shall adopt an operating budget not later than the first day of each fiscal year. The operating budget shall set forth for such fiscal year the estimated revenues and the estimated costs for operations and maintenance, extension and replacement and debt service.

Section 7 - User Fee

Subject to the provisions of this article, there is hereby imposed on each and every developed property with a utility connection, other than exempt property, and the owners thereof, a user fee. The user fee shall be a monthly service charge. The user fee for developed property shall be as follows:

- 1. Single Family Detached Residence: Each residence would be billed \$1.00 per month.
- 2. Other Residential multifamily residential units would be billed \$1.00 per month for each residential dwelling unit.
- 3. Institutional (Governmental and Non-For-Profit Facilities): Institutional uses would be billed \$2.00 per month for each major structure (larger than 1,000 square feet).
- 4. Commercial: Each commercial unit would be billed \$2 per month for each commercial water and sewer connection.

Section 8 – Exemptions

The City may exempt certain uses as conditions or situations warrant. Initially the following exemptions are proposed. These are: undeveloped uncleared lands, <u>cleared and vacant land</u>, roadways, outdoor recreational facilities, and hardships, on a case-by-case basis.

Section 9 - Stormwater Permitting Impact Fees

A one-time stormwater impact fee will be levied on each City building permit which is equivalent to five years of standard utility billing rates. For example, a new single family home would pay \$1.00 per month times 60 months or \$60.00. A one-half (0.5) acre commercial use would pay \$6.00 per month for 60 months or \$360.00. Stormwater impact fees would apply to new development or redeveloped parcels. They would not apply to remodeled facilities where the square footage does not increase by more than 25 percent.

Section 10 - Applicability

This ordinance and the City's authority to impose stormwater assessments pursuant hereto shall be applicable throughout the city.

Section 11 - Program responsibility

It shall be the duty of the City's City Administrator or designee to administer the stormwater management user fee system.

Section 12 - Establish Stormwater Management Fund

All user fees collected by the City shall be paid into a separate fund which is hereby created, to be known as the "Stormwater Management Fund". Such fund shall be used for the purpose of paying the costs of construction, operations, maintenance, and administration of the stormwater facilities of the City and to carry out all other purposes of the system.

Section 13: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith, to the extent of such conflict are hereby repealed.


Purchase of alley space

I am requesting that the City Commission allow me to purchase the 10 ft. easement between the lot that my home sits on and the lot behind it, which I purchased in 2013. My home sits on Block 7, Lot 7 and 8. I purchased the land in 2004 and built a 1350 sq. ft. home in 2008. I have lived in the house full time since 2009. In 2013, I purchased the lot Block 7, Lot 1 and 2, which sits directly behind my house. There is a 10 ft. easement between the two lots and because of that separation, I am not permitted by code to build a secondary structure on Lot 1 and 2. I would like to add an inground swimming pool behind my house on that lot. Currently Lot 1 and 2 tie into my house nicely as a back yard.

In 2009, a shallow ditch was dug in that easement from Shadow Lane to the far side of my lot, where another city owned ditch runs. This 10 ft. easement ditch is not currently maintained and water does not flow to the city ditch that borders the far side of my land. It does hold a small amount of water if there is heavy rain. I would be more than willing to coordinate with the city any drainage improvement that might be deemed necessary.

A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF APALACHICOLA, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION OF A COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT APPLICATION, FINDING THE APPLICATION CONSISTENT/NOT INCONSISTENT WITH THE LOCAL COMPREHENSIVE PLAN, COMMITTING FUNDS TO THE PROJECT, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE CERTAIN DOCUMENTS PERTAINING TO THE GRANT, AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Apalachicola City Commission (hereinafter referred to as the City) desires to improve the welfare of its citizens by providing adequate infrastructure, and

WHEREAS, the City has decided to apply for a Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) to fund infrastructure improvements, and

WHEREAS, the local comprehensive plan encourages the provision of adequate infrastructure,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT IS THEREFORE RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of Apalachicola:

Section 1. A \$650,000 CDBG application will be submitted to the Florida Department of Economic Opportunity (DEO) on or before August 13, 2018.

Section 2. The CDBG application is consistent or not inconsistent with the local comprehensive plan.

Section 3. The City will contribute a minimum of \$25,000 as "leverage funds" to the CDBG project after the CDBG grant application site visit by DEO and prior to the CDBG grant administrative closeout. The City's contribution will be applied to engineering and/or construction costs.

Section 4. The Mayor or Designee is authorized to execute documents pertaining to the grant, including the application, environmental and other certifications, grant award agreement, grant modifications (if any), grant completion/close out documents, and other responses and reports to DEO, subject to appropriate action by the Commission and public participation, if applicable.

Section 5. If any portion of this Resolution is found to be invalid, the remainder shall continue to be in full force and effect.
