II. Approval of Matching Grant Resolution - This meeting is to approve CDBG-DR matching funds for the Application for the CDBG-DR Infrastructure Round II. \$111 million is available in this round of funding. In Round I there were \$505 million in application for \$111 million in funding, Apalachicola received an award of \$3.66 million for stormwater improvements from Avenue D north to Avenue E. With an expectation that there are potentially \$400 million of applications that may be resubmitted and information that many entities that made no application in Round I are now applying, City Staff with Chris Gouras, Chris Holley and Josh Baxley, believe the best decision is to make application for the \$4 million. All of the above parties have a conference call with TA Development at the Florida DEO at 1:00pm today. This group reviewed the application that was made in November, 2020. They are willing to provide insight and comment on areas from that application that may enable the City to improve scores on the new application. City staff will report discovery made from this meeting and report of the recommendation if it is to be changed.

At this time, a resolution is required.

If the City elects to submit application for funding of approximately \$4 million for relocation and replacement of the Headworks at the Wastewater Treatment Plant, the City commits to a match of 5% or approximately \$200,000. The relocation and replacement of the Headworks area requirement of the Wastewater Consent Agenda.

If the City elects to submit application for funding of approximately \$14 million for relocation and replacement of the Headworks and SBRs at the Wastewater Treatment Plant, the City commits to a match of \$500,000.

III. Adjournment
