Resolution 2023-03

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF APALACHICOLA, FLORIDA ADOPTING A
PROPOSED MILLAGE RATE FOR THE LEVY OF AD VALOREM TAXES FOR FISCAL
YEAR 2023-2024 ON ALL TAXABLE PROPERTY LOCATED WITHIN THE CITY OF
APALACHICOLA, SETTING A TENTATIVE BUDGET HEARING DATE, TIME AND
PLACE AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Property Appraiser has certified the quantity of taxable property within the City of Apalachicola for Fiscal Year 2023-2024; and

WHEREAS, the gross taxable value for operating purposes not exempt from taxation within the City of Apalachicola has been certified by the Property Appraiser as \$236,551,780 and

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of Apalachicola adopts a tentative millage rate and sets a tentative budget hearing in order to comply with the Truth in Millage (TRIM) Law.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF APALACHICOLA, the following:

- The City Commission hereby approves a tentative millage rate of 10.00 for ad valorem taxation within the City of Apalachicola, Florida for the 2023-2024 fiscal year.
- 2. The proposed ad valorem millage rate to be levied upon all taxable property located with the City of Apalachicola is greater than the computed rolled back rate of 7.2299 by 38.31%.
- 3. The date for the tentative budget hearing is hereby set for September 6, 2023 at 5:01 p.m. or as soon thereafter as possible, at the Community Center Meeting Room, at 1 Bay Avenue, Apalachicola, Florida.
- 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
