Dennis reported he had, at the City Manager's Request, responded to a number of tree cutting applications and forwarded his response to Greg Harris, Superintendent of Public Services. This was subsequent to a void in the city's Code Enforcement officer position.

A grant application has been submitted for an inventory and assessment of trees in Lafayette Park and Battery Park.
