The City of Apalachicola is requesting sealed statements of interest and qualifications from qualified and licensed firms and individuals to provide **COMPREHENSIVE GENERAL MUNICIPAL ENGINEERING AND COASTAL ENGINEERING SERVICES** complying with the Consultants' Competitive Negotiation Act (CCNA), 287.055 Florida Statute. The selected firm will handle coastal management and general municipal engineering. Contracts will be awarded on a non-exclusive, continuing basis for three (3) years with an option for two (2) one-year extensions.
